President Paxson welcomes attendees and provides an overview of the **BUCC agenda**, which includes the president's report, an introduction of new BUCC members, and a panel discussion on community engagement. This is one of three panel-style conversations that the BUCC is adopting in the Spring of 2023.

In the President's report, **President Christina H. Paxson** discusses her three-fold priorities for the 2022-23 academic year, which include building academic strength, strengthening campus and community, and fostering economic sustainability and operational excellence. Paxson also talks about the values and contributions of higher education and national conversations about affirmative action and academic freedom. Paxson provides updates on other campus and city wide initiatives which include the college access program that Brown will begin for Providence youth, the growth of research at Brown, and negotiations with the City of Providence for a new PILOT (payment in lieu of taxes) agreement. Before introducing the speakers for the community engagement panel, Paxson gestures to the [Brown and Providence](#) websites which captures some of the myriad ways Brown engages with the city of Providence and the state of Rhode Island.

During the panel on community engagement, facilitated by BUCC secretary **Olugbenga Joseph**, guest panelists **Mary Jo Callan** (VP for Community Engagement, Executive Director of the Swearer Center), **Joi Danelle Whitehead** (Director of DEI and Access, Pre College and Undergraduate Programs) **Patricia Poitevien** (Senior Associate Dean for DEI, Division of Biology and Medicine) and **Kelly Clifton** (Head of Library Engagement, University Library) provided their diverse perspectives on, and experience with, community engagement efforts with the city of Providence. Panelists stressed the importance of working collaboratively across units to reduce redundancy and make Brown's engagement more legible for Providence partners, and the

deliberative nature of building trust between campus and community. Afterwards, the panelists answered questions from BUCC attendees on their particular and broader community engagement efforts.
